ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. The candidates should obtain the prescribed application form from the college office.
- The duely filled Application form should be registered in the college office on or before the last date prescribed.
- Selection of the candidates is made on the basis of merit and the policy of the Govt. for unaided colleges.

RULES AND REGULATION

- 1 Every student of the college should obey the rules of college and should be disciplined in the college.
- 2 No student should enter the class room after college classes begins without the permission of the Principal, and at the same time any students coming before the college hour to the college should sit inside the class room and should be occupied in his/her work and no wandering in the college premises.
- 3 In case of unavoidable circumstances if a student wishes to remain absent, should get permission of the Principal.
- 4 A students present in the morning class of the college should not be absent in the afternoon class unless he/she gets permission from the Principal.
- 5 If a student remains absent for the examination of the college, the parents should approach the Principal of the college with proper reason. Absence on the health ground can be considered only after producing the necessary medical certificate from a doctor.
- 6 Minimum 75% of attendance is a must for appearing the annual examination, inspite of repeated warning if a student continuous to be irregular and parents/guardians not bothering to correct the ward, the Principal has every right to issue the T.C. and terminate him/her from the college, according to the Govt. Rule ED 38 SC 164 dated 11/04/1964 2B.
- 7 Absent should inform the office within 9 am. otherwise they will bound to pay fine of Rs. 100/-.
- 8 The Principal of the college has every right to read the personal letter of the student in the college and can be sent to the parents.
- 9 Every students should protect the property of the college. If any student is found damaging the college property, disciplinary action will be taken on such students by the college authority.
- 10 No student is allowed to get their friends and relatives to the college premises and even the parents are not allowed to enter the class room without the permission of Principal.
- 11 Every student must wear the college uniformed, identity card while in the collegepremises. Boys should have decent hair cropping. Hindu girls must have bindi compulsory.
- 12 No student should bring mobile/cell phone to college, a fine of Rs.500/- & mobile will not returned.
- 13 Students are not supposed to eat chewing gum, chocolates any outside junk food inside the college premises.
- 14 No students should bring Two Wheeler or Four Wheeler to the college. Only bicycle is allowed.
- 15 It is parents responsibility to see their ward travel in safe transport system.
